



HEAT RIBBON WORKER DUTIES

Before the meet begins:

- Get heat ribbons from Awards Coordinator. Check in the computer room if you can't find her.

During the meet:

- Stand at the side of the pool opposite the blocks.
- For each heat of **8 and under** and **9-10 year old** individual races, watch to see which swimmer touches the wall first. (Don't ask timers for times, just visually determine who was first.) **DO NOT GIVE RIBBONS OUT FOR RELAYS.**
- Give a heat ribbon to this swimmer (even if it was a DQ).
- If it's too close to tell, give one to each swimmer that touched first.
- Older swimmers do not receive heat ribbons.

After the meet:

- Return the remaining heat ribbons to the awards table inside the clubhouse.
