



TIMER DUTIES

Before the Meet:

- Get stop watch at check in table
- Get lane assignment
- Attend the timer meeting
- Determine which of the 3 timers in your assigned lane will hold the clipboard and write down times

During the Meet:

- For each race, start your watch with the strobe light (not the horn)
- Time your lane
- As soon as the swimmer touches the wall, stop your watch
- Give the time to the timer with the clipboard
- Record times even if it is a DQ
- If you miss the start, raise your hand for the back up timer to come time your lane
- If you need a bathroom break, raise your hand for the back up timer
- If a swimmer is moved to a different lane, only the timers with the swimmer in their lane need to time the race

After the Meet

- Give stopwatches and clipboards to the Head Timer
